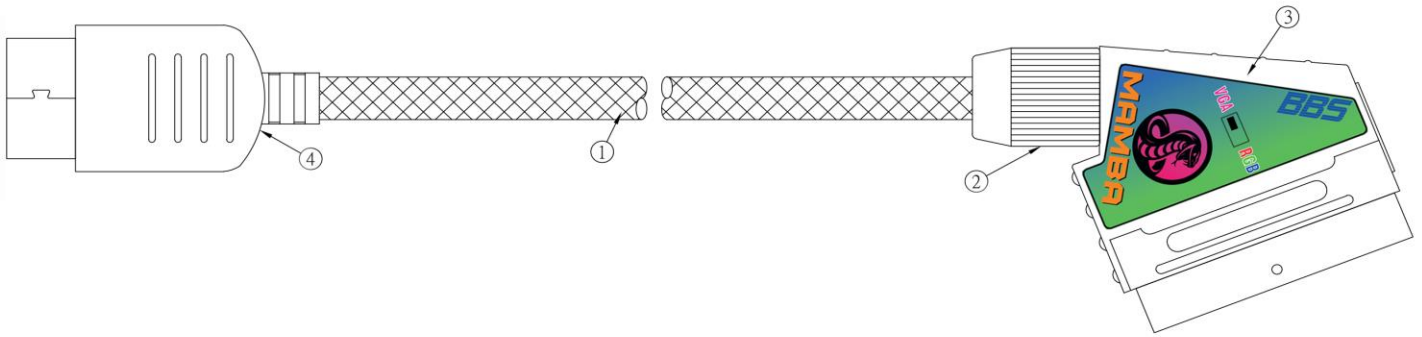




MAMBA

PREMIUM SCART CABLE FOR THE DREAMCAST

INSTRUCTION MANUAL



Mamba is a specially made Scart cable with individually shielded, impedance matching, 75 Ohm coaxial cables, so it delivers unparalleled audio and video quality. It's compatible with all Dreamcast revisions from every region, and supports all video resolutions from 480i to 480p. So, you can play every game released in RGB or VGA modes. With the MAMBA, you'll experience your favorite Dreamcast games like never before, with crystal clear graphics and immersive sound.

Parts:

1. Individually shielded, 75ohm impedance matching, coaxial cables prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI) and crosstalk for superior output quality.
Length: 1.8m/6 feet.
2. Scart plug with custom signal processing circuit.
3. RGB output mode switch, RGB (15KHz) or VGA (31KHz).
4. Dreamcast AV plug.

Instructions:

1. Make sure your TV and Dreamcast is turned off.
2. Connect your Mamba's Dreamcast AV plug (4) to your console's AV port on the back.
3. Choose RGB or VGA mode by changing to the desired position of the mode switch (3).
4. Connect the Scart plug (2) to your TV, monitor, upscaler etc...

VGA Switch Trick Instructions:

RGB mode can be set by the help of RGB Mode Switch (3). When it's in the RGB position, it displays 15khz RGB video, or 480i/240p. If you change it to the VGA position, it will display 31khz VGA video or 480p. Some games are not compatible with the VGA mode, also the console checks the video mode while booting, so it refuses to boot if the game doesn't support the VGA mode. To eliminate this problem, you can trick the console by changing to the VGA position immediately while it's booting in RGB mode (after the VMU beeps, or the disc spins faster).

Note: Consumer TVs can't handle 480p video signal through Scart, so in order to use the VGA mode you need a compatible display or an upscaler or a Scart converter with HDMI or Component (YPbPr) outputs.
